## Municipal Tax Penalty Relief

Payment of all taxes will remain at the regular scheduled due dates for 2020, April 24, August 28 and October 30.

Late payment penalties will not be applied on the April 24th, 2020 tax payment until after August 2020.

**Please note** that any post-dated cheques will be processed on the dates the cheques were written for payment. EFT payments scheduled for April 24 and

August 28 will be processed as usual unless you call to cancel or make an adjustment.

## COVID-19: Off-peak Electricity Pricing

If you are a time-of-use (TOU) hydro customer then keep an eye on your hydro bills. As of March 24th the Provincial Government under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act is providing temporary emergency relief for some electricity customers. Residential and small business customers and farms on TOU pricing under the OEB's Regulated Price Plan (RPP) will pay 10.1 ¢/kWh no matter what time of day the electricity is consumed. This means that these TOU customers will be paying the off-peak price throughout the day.


The Government has indicated that it intends to keep the 10.1 ¢/kWh pricing in place for 45 days. Do keep in mind that the pricing change does not apply to customers that pay tiered rates and the pricing change also does not apply to RPP customers that have opted out of the RPP in favour of market-based pricing or a contract with an electricity retailer. # Shuniah Public Works Spring 2020

As spring approaches the public is advised to exercise caution in and around area waterways. High flows, melting ice and unstable banks could be dangerous. Parents and caregivers are advised to keep children away from all waterways and discuss the hazards of flooding and fast flowing water.

LOAD RESTRICTIONS are in effect from March 9th until late May as a means to try to protect the integrity of the roads during the spring thaw. Please keep this time period in mind if you are planning to have building supplies or gravel products delivered to your property.

## Illegal Dumping of Yard Waste and Debris

Residents are required to dispose of yard waste and debris at the Shuniah Landfill Sites, not alongside roadways and trails that lead into the bush that are quite often private property. If you don't want the material in your yard chances are neither do your neighbors.

# These Are Not Normal Times

We've heard this expression many times over the past few weeks. I think it almost speaks more about the future than it does about the present. We all want things to be back to normal as we all have a much greater appreciation for 'normal'. While the Municipality has not declared an emergency it's important to remind residents that we are all under a declaration of emergency through the Ontario government. Based on this declaration and following the advice of our local District Health Unit our facilities will remain closed and we will continue to focus on essential services until both the emergency is lifted and we find new ways to provide municipal services while protecting the health of our employees and residents.

It's been a significant adjustment for staff and Council with the closing of the municipal office, working from home, having employees working staggered shifts, taking necessary precautionary actions for staff and the public, staying connected with agencies and keep abreast of changing Provincial legislation. All municipal staff will continue to check their email and phone messages. We'll do our best to respond to enquiries and keep the Shuniah Website and Facebook updated with the status of municipal operations. All municipal staff have made modifications to their departments to maintain continuity of operations. We have modified the process for receiving building permit applications and while we may be issuing building permits it will be up to the property owner to follow all applicable provincial laws that may continue to have restrictions on what construction is allowed. Do keep in mind that

the Chief Building Official will only be doing inspections at this time if there is nobody on the property site. The roads department has re-focused their operations to essential services only and we have been fortunate to keep our landfill hours of operation the same with some modification to how we receive waste at the site. The Fire Chief has been splitting his time primarily between fire suppression and his role as CEMC as it relates to emergency planning. The Treasurer made recommendations accepted by Council for property tax relief. Late payment penalties will not be applied on the second tax installment due on April 24th. Residents have been given an extra three months to pay the second property tax installment. Notices through our CivicWeb, Website and Facebook announced the change and for residents to contact the municipal office if they wanted a hold put on cheques that had not yet been processed, post-dated cheques or scheduled EFT payments. Council has also passed a by-law to allow for video conferencing of Council Meetings and the Planning Ad Hoc committee continues to work on the draft Official Plan as they review and accommodate the comments received from the Province.

For the most current information on municipal operations please check the Shuniah website for updates and please keep informed of current TBDHU recommendations and Provincial orders from the Premier during this pandemic emergency. The solution to this pandemic is going to take everyone's participation. Be safe and stay home.

## SOCIAL DISTANCING

Together, we can slow the spread of COVID-19 by making a conscious effort to keep a physical distance between each other. Social distancing is proven to be one of the most effective ways to reduce the spread of illness during an outbreak. With patience and cooperation, we can all do our part.

**What does Social Distancing mean?**



This means making changes in your everyday routines in order to minimize close contact with others, including:

- avoiding crowded places and non-essential gatherings
- avoiding common greetings, such as handshakes
- limiting contact with people at higher risk (e.g. older adults and those in poor health)
- keeping a distance of at least 2 arms lengths (approximately 2 metres) from others, as much as possible

**Here's how you can practice social distancing:**



- greet with a wave instead of a handshake, a kiss or a hug
- stay home as much as possible, including for meals and entertainment
- shop or take public transportation during off-peak hours
- conduct virtual meetings
- host virtual playdates for your kids
- use technology to keep in touch with friends and family

If possible,



- use food delivery services or online shopping
- exercise at home or outside
- work from home

**Remember to:**



- wash your hands often for at least 20 seconds and avoid touching your face
- cough or sneeze into the bend of your arm
- avoid touching surfaces people touch often

**If you're concerned you may have COVID-19:**



- separate yourself from others as soon as you have symptoms
- if you are outside the home when a symptom develops, go home immediately and avoid taking public transit
- stay home and follow the advice of your Public Health Authority, who may recommend self-isolation
- call ahead to a health care provider if you are ill and seeking medical attention



# Soil Mates Community Gardens in Limbo

The Ontario Government has placed Virus Pandemic prevention regulations closing all recreation areas as well as all Community Gardens declaring them non-essential and the Shuniah Rec Center Soil Mates is no exception. I was particularly saddened to read that the Roots to Harvest "Garden like a Boss" seminar was cancelled because they have a similar non-essential status with their Water St. facility.

Some time in mid March I received a petition from Sustain Ontario (a Community Growing Network) to identify Community Gardens as an Essential Service. I endorsed the petition on behalf of the Shuniah Soil Mates and my signature at that time was #579 or thereabouts. As of this writing the signatures are over 6000 and counting. 

Please note that the 2020 Private Landowner's Tree Seedling Assistance Program has been postponed indefinitely. Additionally, the 2020 Wine Tasting & Dinner fundraising event and the 2020 Dorion Birding Festival have been cancelled. Keep an eye on the LRCA's website and social media channels for more information about closures and cancellations.

Please note that our Conservation Areas are currently open at the time of writing; however, due to the evolving situation surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic, things can change very quickly. As such, we ask that you please visit our website regularly and follow us on Facebook for up-to-date information.

In the meantime, please note that washrooms, shelters and benches are closed. Conservation Areas are not being maintained. We highly suggest you all stay vigilant with physical distancing and only leave your home if absolutely necessary; however, we recognize the fact that getting outside is beneficial to our physical and mental health. That being said, if you do find yourself in one of the LRCA's Conservation Areas, you MUST practice physical distancing of at least 2 metres between you and anyone else. You also must remove all garbage from the area that you bring in with you, as we have limited ability to empty our garbage cans. Pets must also be on-leash at all times and must be picked up after.

There has been a marked increase in vandalism and unwanted, irresponsible behaviour in our Conservation Areas, including but not limited to the destruction of property, dumping of garbage, and graffiti. If our Conservation Areas are to remain open, visitors must respect the rules and regulations that have been put in place for their own safety.
